


How to show contact form data on another Scribe page?

- 1 Open contact form and click on Actions.




2 Add redirect action.


3 Edit the newly added redirect action.



6 Then copy the mail tag as per your requirement. And paste the mail tag inside the "Fields to pass as URL query parameters, separated by commas".

7 Then copy the "shortcode" and paste it on your page.
